Owings & John Brown to Dennis Purcell - - whereas under terms of William Bard, Purcell settled and improved 1/4 acre lot, half of a 1/2 acre lot, lot #96 in the town of Bardstown, he relinquishes his claim to a 3 acre outlot for title to the 1/4 acres and Owings for \$50 conveys title to the other half of lot #96.

James Rogers Jr. and wife Polly to Dennis Purcell - - 210 pounds - - 100 acres on Buffalo Creek, it being a part of James Rogers Sr.'s preemption and includes the house where James Rogers Jr. lives.

Nelson Co., Kentucky Will Book C, Pages 399 - 400

In the name of God amen I Dennis Pursley of Nelson County and State of Kentucky being indisposed but of sound mind and natural understanding feell disposed to settle my worldly business that I may be the better prepared to leave this world when it pleases the Lord to call me home. I constitute and appoint this my last will and testament as follows.

First it is my will and desire that my two daughters, Elizabeth and Rebekah should have my dwelling place with one half of my land during both their lives also all my stock except a young brown mare, plantation utensils and household furniture of every description to them and their heirs forever.

Second it is my will and desire that my son Daniel shall have the other half of my land where I now live from and after my decease and likewise the whole of it after the death of my two daughters before mentioned also one young brown mare to him and his heirs forever.

Lastly it is my will and desire that all my children not married above shall have all the money that I may have at my death or may be due me to be equally divided amongst them by my son Daniel.

In testimony whereof I have set my hand and seal this 24th day of April 1815.
